Dear Friends,

From 2011 to 2016, 800 children with special needs went missing across the nation. The fear of a child wandering off or going missing is a constant stress and anxiety for so many special needs families. To help address this, Dutchess County Executive Marcus Molinaro is pleased to bring to Dutchess County the *Life Button Program* to help families and first responders be able to track children who wander or go missing and ensure their safe return using the Life Button 24 device.

Life Button is a device that provides geo-fencing of a property and alerts parents if a child has left the safety of their premises. Geo-fencing defines geographical boundaries, such as a homeowner's property, a school property or a specific radius area. If the child wearing the Life Button leaves the defined area, the device will immediately alert the Life Button call center to send a text to alert the parent. Within minutes, if the text goes unanswered, Life Button call center will immediately contact local emergency dispatch with an alert that a child has gone missing. The Life Button's GPS locating system works anywhere in the Continental United States where there is cellular service. Parents can also use the device to locate their child by texting the word TRACK, to receive a GPS location directly on their cell phone on the location of the child.

Having successfully launched a small pilot of the Life Button program in the fall of 2017 for individuals who are diagnosed with a developmental disability and present a significant risk behavior of wandering or going missing this program is now being expanded into the scope of services Dutchess County can offer families.
