TYPES OF VOLUNTEERS:

Volunteers must be at least 13 years of age; those 13 through 15 years old must be accompanied by an adult. For Service Volunteers, it is requested you do not bring young children to your assignment.

Volunteer to Cheer: Individuals or groups that would like to cheer on our athletes during competition. Fans in the stands! This is a very important role, as many athletes travel far and do not always have the opportunity for their families to attend and cheer them on. Social volunteers can be ANY AGE.
